



Dear customers of PowerBox Systems and MULTIPLEX,

We are delighted to be able to inform you that PowerBox Systems and MULTIPLEX have agreed to collaborate in the field of radio control technology.

Since the announcement of our cooperation at the "Faszination Modellbau" Fair in Friedrichshafen on 1 November 2019, many customers have contacted us to enquire what this means, and how the collaboration will work. Over all three days of the Fair our plans were greeted with an overwhelmingly positive reaction, and we would now like to provide a more accurate picture for all our customers, including those who were not present at the Fair:

The purpose of our collaboration is that MULTIPLEX will in future distribute the PowerBox CORE transmitter with integrated M-LINK technology, and PowerBox Systems will begin working on the hardware and software implementation as quickly as possible. In fact, the task of incorporating M-LINK technology within the internal space available is not that difficult, as the CORE transmitter was developed from the start with this kind of retro-fit work in mind - both in electronic and mechanical terms. The full M-LINK system will be integrated, which means that it will be possible to continue to use the full range of functions of all M-LINK receivers and sensors in the usual way. Naturally the CORE transmission system will continue to be available, so the customer will have the choice of specifying an M-LINK receiver or a PowerBox receiver when binding receivers!

A conversion option will be made available for CORE transmitters which have already been sold. This will require the transmitter to be sent in to PowerBox Systems for the M-LINK hardware implementation.

Servicing of transmitters will be carried out by PowerBox Systems, but minor conversion or retro-fit processes will also be carried out by the MULTIPLEX Service Department. Updates to the CORE firmware will be the same for all transmitters, and will be supplied by PowerBox Systems at no charge - including the implementation of the full range of functions.

Naturally a large part of the implementation procedure will be taken up by comprehensive testing, but we plan to ship the initial batch of CORE transmitters with M-LINK in Spring 2020. The price of the CORE M-LINK set will be around 2.690 €, and will include the CORE transmitter, one M-LINK RX-9-DR receiver, transmitter case and battery charger.

We're looking forward to great cooperation!
